# FROM THE SKIPPER SARAH WILSON



Good afternoon and welcome to this afternoon's game against Sunderland.

The result against Birmingham in our last home game was huge for us, we know on our day what we're capable of and what we can achieve. We were fully aware of Birmingham's strengths but we had our own plan that we executed well.

Then we went to Charlton and didn't come away from defeat due to poor performance, which sometimes is really difficult to overcome. We knew that we just had to get our heads down and get back to work. We showed great character throughout the squad that week and got what we fully deserved.

The result against Blackburn, again showed great character, resilience and adaptability. We made changes, as did they, and they threatened us. We were 1-0 down but had to fight to get back into the game. Once again we fully deserved to come away with the win.

It's so important that we have depth in the squad. It's a long season and when the League Cup comes along the games come thick and fast. The result against Blackburn allowed some rotation and allowed us to work on different things. We were able to show not only the strength in depth but also the togetherness to fight back for the win.

The result against Newcastle last weekend was a big one. We know that performance wise we were well below par. We had to deal with lots of early threats and I was

outstanding in goal. Derby games are tough, especially as the away team, facing the home fans. But once again we showed what we were about. We dug out a very good result, in games like that, that's all that matters.

All the way through the game our travelling fans backed us and never once allowed the home fans to drown them out, which is impressive. To win in the manner that we did and to celebrate with them was just fantastic. It's up there with one of my favourite memories and will stay with us for a very long time.

We're expecting another incredibly difficult test today. We know what Sunderland are capable of and the football they play. It's always a battle in games like this so it's really important that we focus on ourselves and remain on task.

The fans are going to be so crucial today. We know that they're going to be backing us all of the way and we can't wait to get back out here at Maiden Castle.

Durham Women snatched a late victory to beat Newcastle United 1-0 in the first North East Derby of the Barclays Women's Championship season.

Newcastle started the brighter as Saunders kept out a huge chance for Shania Hayles in the 14th minute.

Saunders was called back into action on the half-hour mark and produced a miraculous save to deny Rachel Furness.

Durham's first big chance came in the 35th minute after Mollie Lambert crossed to Kaila Novak but Claudia Moan rescued Newcastle with a big save.

The Magpies came agonisingly close to taking the lead just before half-time through Amber Keegan-Stobbs but Saunders twice tipped her efforts onto the bar.

Durham grew into the second half and came close to breaking the deadlock in the 66th minute through a great team move but Novak couldn't keep her shot down.

Carly Johns was at the forefront of Durham's attacks and nearly found herself on the scoresheet on 76 minutes but her shot was too high.

The deadlock was finally broken in the 89th minute as Johns' shot was blocked only as far as Lambert who scrambled the ball across the line.

After a series of other chances in the six added minutes at the end of the second half, Durham managed to hold on to secure the three points.

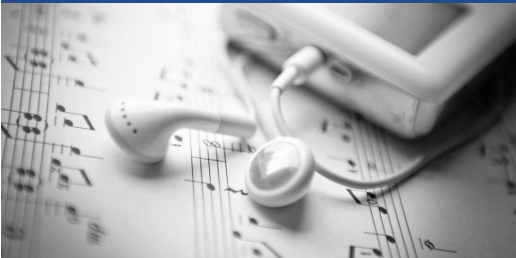


## **DREAM HOLIDAY DESTINATION...**

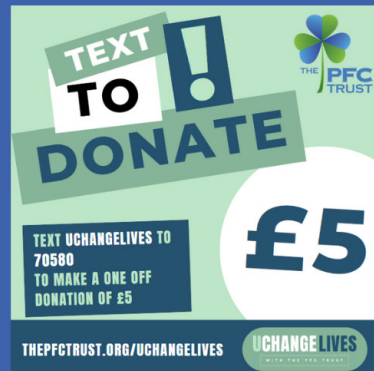

THE BIG INTERVIEW  
**GRACE AYRE**



**Grace Ayre sat down with us to discuss our back-to-back derbies in what has been a rollercoaster Barclays Women's Championship so far.**

"I think we've had a really good start," she said.

"We've picked up a few points and we have good performances to show for it as well."

Ayre has played in every game so far this season, winning five out of six in the league as well as a win at Blackburn in the opening fixture of the Women's League Cup.

"I think the new regime suits my style," she admitted.

"I like to attack and get forward so I think that the way we play allows me to do that and help out the team."

After coming through the youth ranks at Durham, Ayre has seen a plethora of new faces join the club - with five new faces arriving ahead of this season alone.

So how have they slotted in?

"I think the group is really together this year," added the defender.

"A few new good players has

done us good and we've got the points because of them."

Today, Durham play for the first time since beating local rivals Newcastle United 1-0 at Kingston Park courtesy of a late Mollie Lambert winner.

"Everyone's still buzzing," said Ayre of that game.

"It's been a good time to have a little break, though, and get back down to Earth so we can go again for another big derby."

Going into consecutive derbies, Ayre believes the team are in a good spot.

"Confidence is high right now, definitely.

"We're feeling good, obviously we've had brilliant results so we are really looking forward to going out there."

She also urges the fans to bring the noise once again for the battle of the Wear - with a bumper crowd expected today at Maiden Castle.

"Be as loud as you were at Kingston Park," she urged.

"You were great and it was great to celebrate with you at the end so hopefully we can do it again at home."

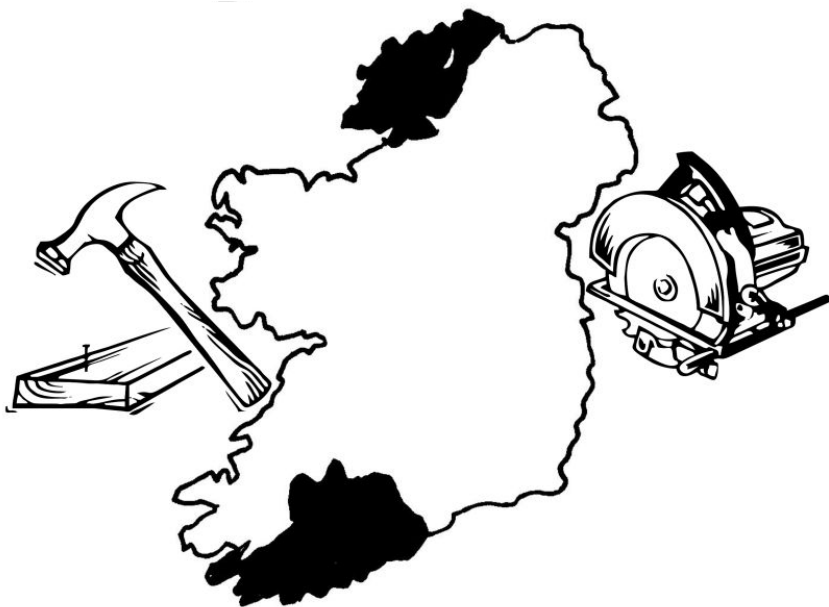

**WITH MARK DONNELLY**

## **What is your role at Durham?**

Marketing & Operations Manager - so everything other than football, basically! (although I do get involved with that in some capacities too!). I look after our website, social media, marketing strategy and also - alongside Lee and Dawn - make sure everything runs smoothly off the field through the week and then on match days.

## **How long have you been with the club?**

I joined in 2015 when I moved to the North East. My first game was a 1-1 draw away at Everton.

## **What has your career in football and sport been like before joining Durham?**

I worked with Doncaster Rovers Belles for three seasons before joining Durham. I've also worked with the Sunderland Echo, Carlisle United and England national teams.

## **What has your best memory at Durham been?**

There are so, so many - most of which couldn't be printed here in good faith. Beating Liverpool during the COVID season is right up there - that day it felt like absolutely nothing was going to stop us winning the league. The victories over Manchester United are also up there, as well as the game with Chelsea in 2019. Selfishly, the Manchester City game last year is a major highlight despite the result. It was our biggest ever crowd, our quickest sell-out and a really intense month-long period of work to get that game on and to facilitate things like the BBC broadcast. But what a day it was! Newcastle a fortnight ago is also a contender - we'll all remember those scenes at full-time for a long time.

## **What is a standard week like in your role?**

There's no such thing as a standard week, and I love that. Every day is varied and brings its own challenges and opportunities which keeps things exciting! But generally, I'll always be working towards the weekend fixture - organising everything internally and with the opposition, referee, league etc.

## **What do you enjoy doing away from football?**

Watch more football! I'm a massive Carlisle United fan so watch them whenever I can.

## **What's your favourite TV series?**

It's Always Sunny in Philadelphia

## **What music do you listen to before a game?**

I love country music so I've started playing that in the car on the way to games this season. I'm not sure if Lee is on board with it though.

## **What's the best part about your role and working in football?**

The people. We have an incredible group of players and staff and working with them is an absolute joy.

## **What advice would you give to someone looking to work in football?**

Get experience. There are thousands of people who want to work in football, so separate yourself from all their CVs by getting some real world experience. You'll learn so much from just being inside a football club and seeing how everything works - even the departments that aren't connected to the field you want to work in.



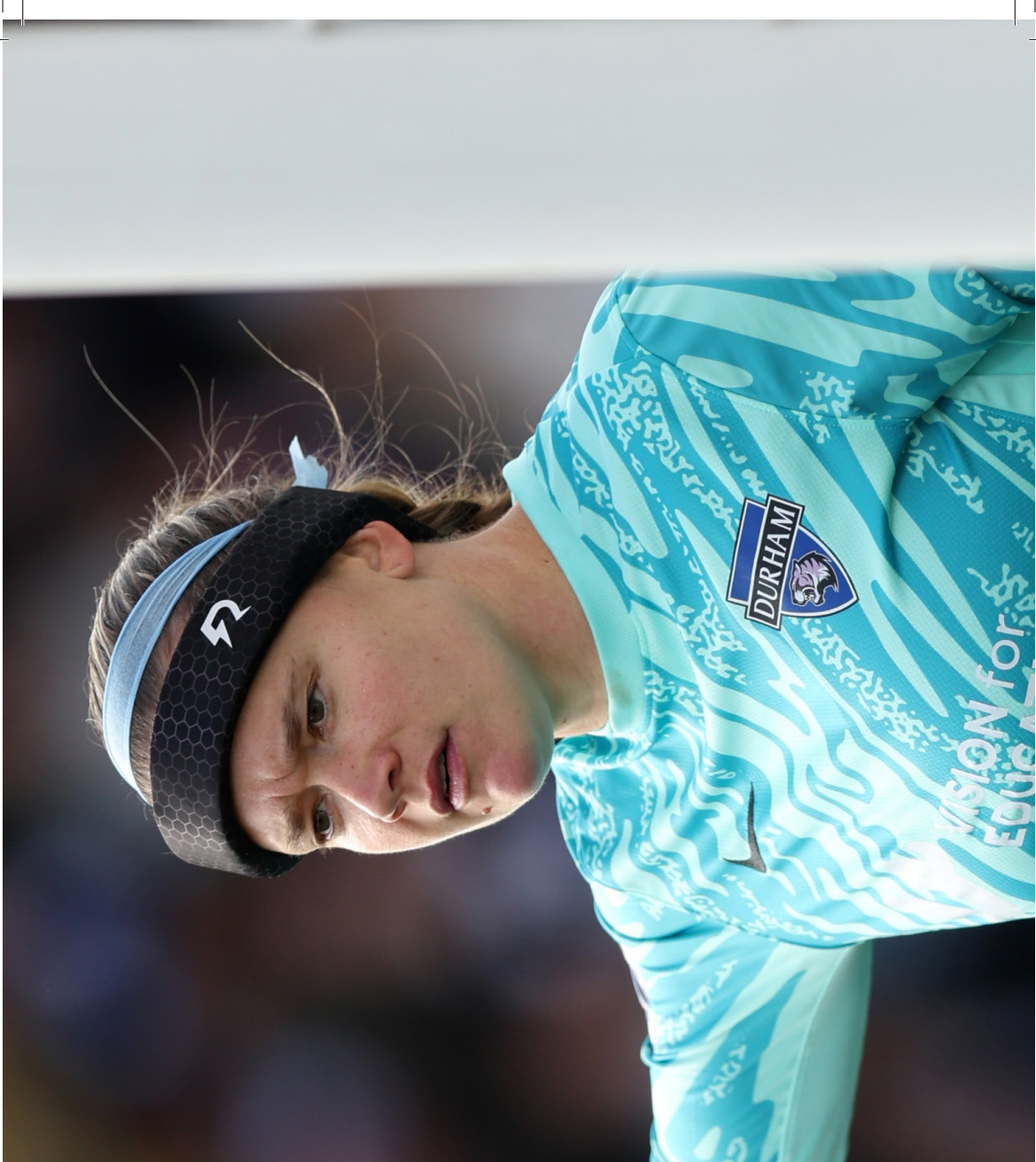

## INTRODUCING **SUNDERLAND**

After featuring in national and regional leagues during the early 1990s, Sunderland Ladies merged with Blyth Spartans Kestrels following promotion in 1999 and the team enjoyed successful spells in the top two divisions, finishing seventh in the FA Women's Premier League in 2000-01.

Sunderland has a rich history of producing and developing some of the country's best talent, including Jill Scott, Steph Houghton, Lucy Bronze, Jordan Nobbs and Beth Mead.

Nicknamed 'the Lassies', the team won the inaugural FA WSL 2 in 2014, and thus spent the next four seasons in the top flight, spearheaded by the

goalscoring of Mead.

Mel Reay's side earned promotion back to the Barclays Women's Championship in 2021, and last season, finished third in the division with 41 points from 22 games.

The Black Cats started this season with defeats to promotion hopefuls Birmingham City and Southampton - before beating London City Lionesses in their third outing.

That was followed by a Women's League Cup win over Sheffield United and a thrilling 3-3 draw at Charlton Athletic, before Sunderland fell to a narrow 2-1 defeat to Newcastle United last week.



# 23 ONE TO WATCH

## JENNA DEAR

After six years playing abroad in Norway and France, midfielder Jenna Dear returned to England via Sunderland in 2023. The Hayes-born midfielder has played in all five of Sunderland's games so far this Barclays Women's Championship season – scoring in their dramatic 3-3 draw against Charlton at the Valley. Last season, she scored six goals in all competitions for the Black Cats.

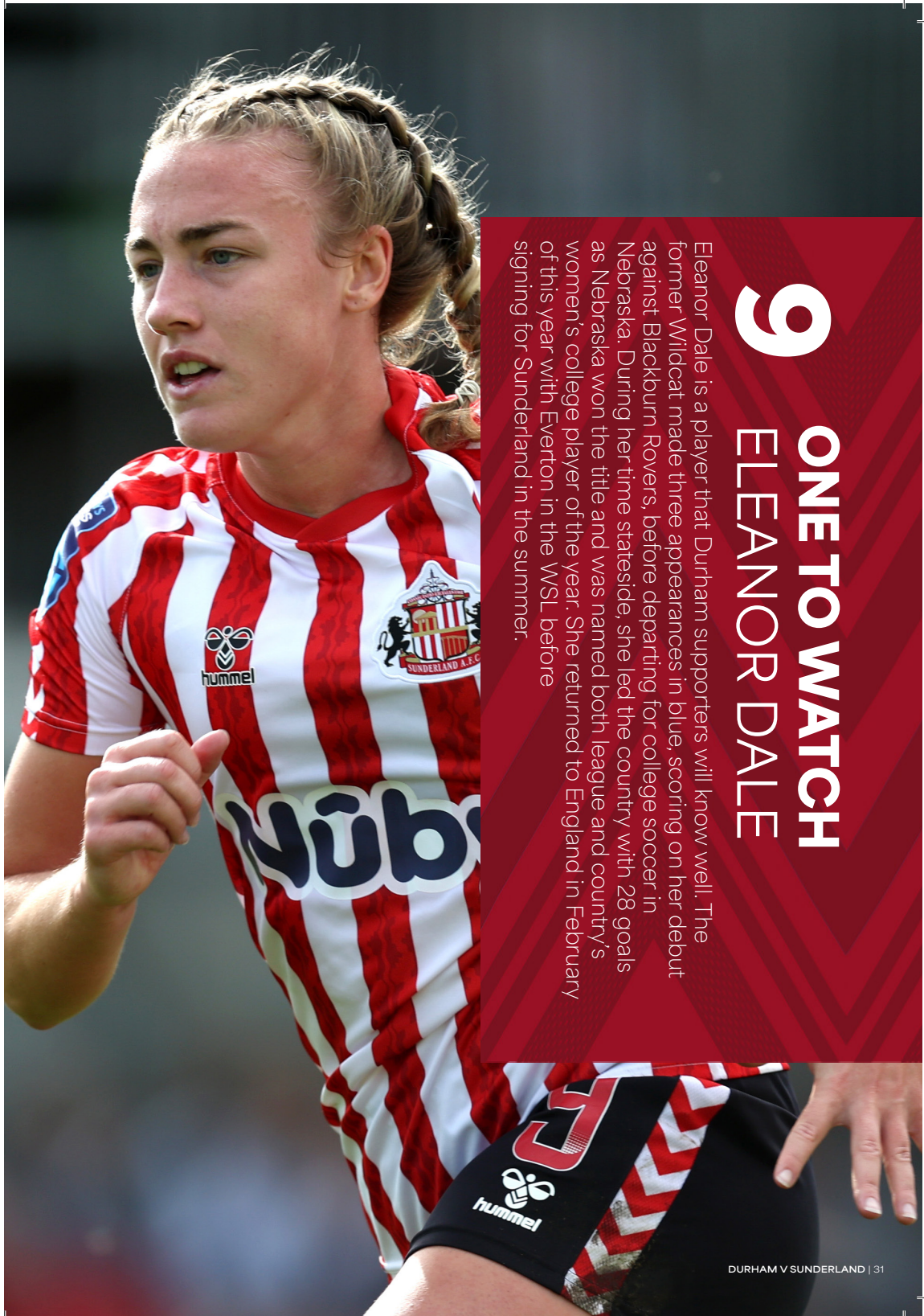

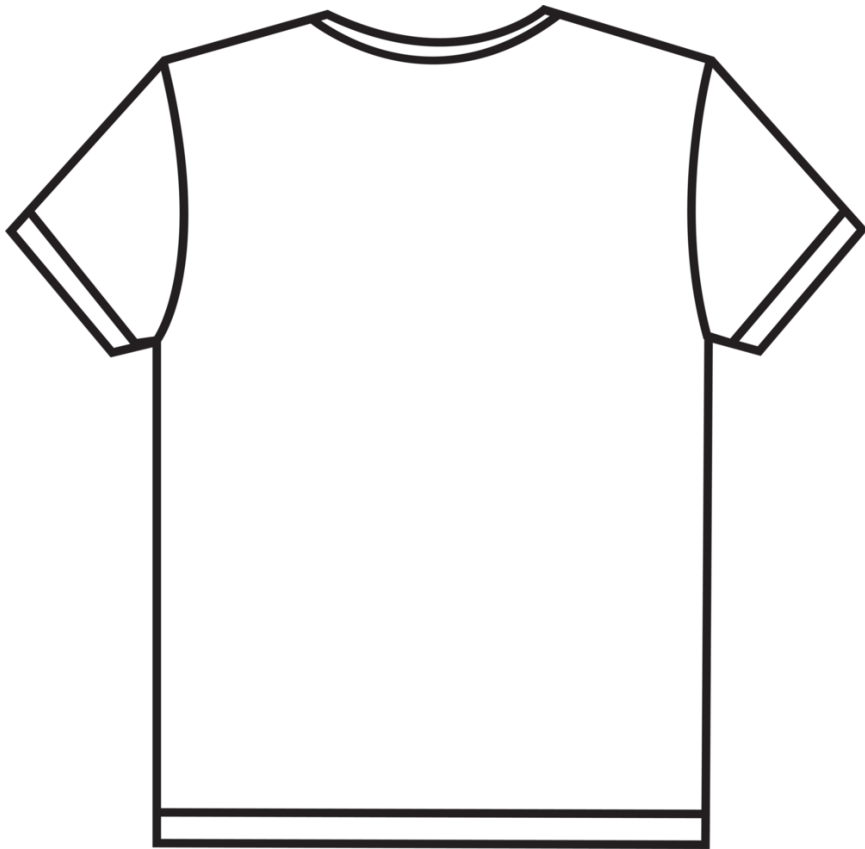
