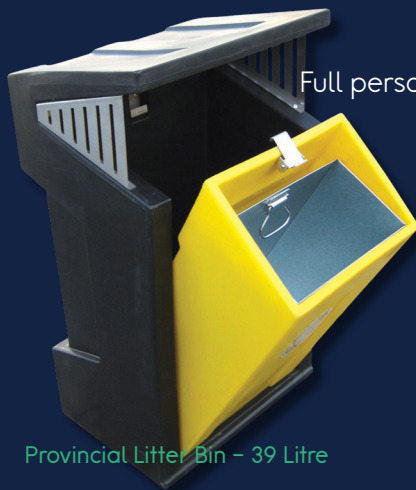

Mollie Lambert's late strike saw Durham Women claim a hard-fought point at Southampton.

The midfielder kept her cool to slot home from inside the area to cancel-out Aimee Palmer's opener and ensure the Blues took a share of the spoils back to the North East.

After a fairly even start, the hosts grew into the game - with Molly Pike firing over from range in the first real chance of the afternoon.

And with 19 minutes on the clock, the Saints struck. After a sustained spell of pressure on the edge of the box, Palmer's side-footed delivery caught everyone off guard and looped in at the back post.

Durham responded well and were within inches of a leveller when Sarah Wilson steered a header wide at the back post following a corner.

Pike then struck wide in first half injury time before the Blues started strongly after the restart - Hannah Blake curling wide and Grace Ayre seeing a delivery cleared before she could connect with a header.

But Durham had to remain wary at the back and Tatiana Saunders made a string of fine stops and blocks during a goal-line scramble.

The visitors started to assert themselves more on the game and deservedly drew level with five minutes remaining. Eleanor Ryan-Doyle did well to keep the ball alive before Carly Johns flicked it in behind for Lambert, who kept her cool and finished calmly at the near post.

There was still time for one more big chance each - Becky Salicki seeing a header cleared off the line and Lucia Kendall firing wide at the other end - but the spoils were ultimately shared.

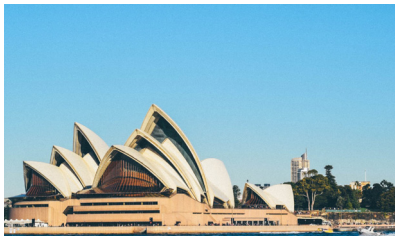

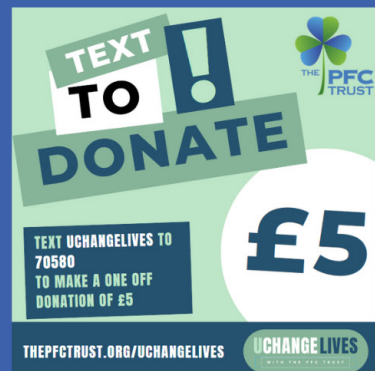

**HANNAH BLAKE**



## **How've you found your first few months at the Club?**

"I've really enjoyed it.

"It's gone by pretty quickly but it feels like I've been here a while which is credit to the girls and the staff and the club as a whole - they've made me feel really welcome.

"It was important to me to find a home away from home and I think Durham is definitely somewhere that I can call home for now."

## **You're not the only Kiwi in the squad - Michaela Foster coming in too - is it nice to have a fellow compatriot around the place?**

"We both joked 'What were the odds of us both being here after playing together from a young age?' because we've known each other since we were 13 or 14.

"It has been great having her around, and I think she is really coming out of her shell.

"It's nice having a familiar face and familiar accent amongst all the Brits."

## **What's it been like living in the North East? Like you say it's a long way from home - how've you managed?**

"A transition to what I've been used to - the weather especially.

"But it is a beautiful place, I think the people are really friendly, and I heard that before even coming here so I can say that definitely rings true."

## **You've already been involved in some massive games - what have you made of English football so far?**

"English football is great.

"I think one of the motivations for coming here was the passion there is

for football and how that translates onto the pitch.

“We’re obviously doing well so far as a team and I think each week we grow with confidence so it has been really enjoyable.”

**You’ll know by now how important the connection is with the supporters - how does it translate to you as non-local players?**

“The fans have been great with my experiences so far, even away games, we get a cohort which we all speak so highly of because of their passion and dedication to Durham and that only helps us.

“Like I say, we’ve performed well, and I think a lot of that can be attributed to them - they are the 12th player out there.”

**How would you compare Durham to where you’ve played your football elsewhere in your career?**

“It’s an interesting one, definitely different to what I experienced in Australia.

“The biggest things probably come down to the fans like I’ve mentioned, and that love English fans and players have for the game - it’s like every game is like a battle to get three points and that only adds to the level of play and adds to what’s on the line which I’ve enjoyed.

“I’m glad I’ve made the move over here because of that.”

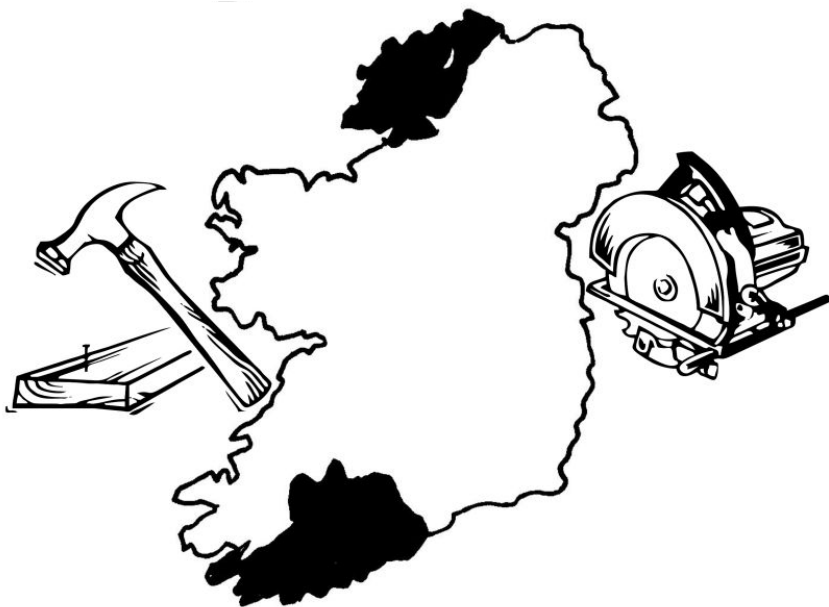

WITH GEORGE ANTHONY

## **What is your role at Durham?**

My role is the First Team Assistant Coach and Analyst

## **How long have you been with the club?**

I have been at the club for eight months now, having joined from Oxford United Women in April.

## **What has your career in football and sport been like before joining Durham?**

Prior to joining Durham I have worked in various coaching and teaching roles in the USA, Sweden and UK, in addition to playing in the USA on a scholarship before transitioning into coaching.

These roles have been within the women's game and have varied across levels and ages with senior experience coaching in the NCAA & The FA Women's National League before moving into the Championship with Durham.

## **What has your best memory at Durham been?**

In the short time I have been with Durham, I have already created many special memories.

However, I think the standout so far for me was the win vs Birmingham on the last day of the season 23/24, as this was my first win with the club, first home game and was my first introduction to our fans at Maiden Castle.

## **What is a standard week like in your role?**

Is any week in football a standard week? The week usually starts with review of our previous game(s) in addition to planning/ preparation for analysis across the rest of the week, linking in with session planning with the MDT Staff.

In addition to coaching within the main team sessions, I also work with players in small groups and or individually across the week for additional technical and analysis sessions.

## **What do you enjoy doing away from football?**

Away from football I enjoy playing very average golf and have found there are some nice courses up here. Otherwise I enjoy cooking, going to the gym and have been enjoying being closer to the coast.

## **What's your favourite TV series?**

This is a tough one but it would probably have to be Band of Brothers. It's a great series if you have never watched it.

## **What music do you listen to before a game?**

It's not often I listen to music before the game anymore, I did that more so when I played but if I do, it is usually country music.

## **What's the best part about your role and working in football?**

One of the best parts of the role is I am fortunate to work with an ambitious and dedicated group of staff and players, who want to push and challenge themselves every day to be the best they can. Another is being on the pitch, competing for points each weekend and working within a sport I love every day.

## **What advice would you give to someone looking to work in football?**

Be hardworking, be ambitious, don't be afraid to network and be open to learning and gaining different experiences at every opportunity you can.

## INTRODUCING LONDON CITY

London City Lionesses were founded in 2019, and are currently participating in their sixth consecutive Barclays Women's Championship season.

In their inaugural campaign, the Pride's first goal was scored by Grace Neville and assisted by Lucy Fitzgerald, both still ever-present members at the club.

December 2023 saw the arrival of Michele Kang as owner, who also leads the Washington Spirit and Olympique Lyonnais Féminin from the boardroom.

Her arrival heralded a new era for the club and, over the sum-

mer, there were changes on and off the pitch.

Jocelyn Precheur arrived as Head Coach and brought with him a star-studded squad of signings - including Swedish trio Kosovare Asllani, Sofia Jakobsson and Julia Roddar and World Cup winner Maria Perez.

And London City have enjoyed a fine start to the campaign, losing just twice and currently sitting second in the table - level on points with Durham and just three points behind league leaders Birmingham City having played a game less.

London City lost to Birmingham last time out, and will be looking to bounce back today.



# 9 ONE TO WATCH KOSOVARE ASLLANI

Kosovare Asllani has had an impressive journey prior to arriving in the capital city. After a healthy goal return in France for PSG over four years, Asllani joined Manchester City in 2016, where she won the WSL and FA Cup. She was Real Madrid's first Galáctica after purchasing a license for women's football in 2019, and she then joined AC Milan in 2022. Asllani joined the Sweden setup in 2008 and has represented them at five major tournaments – scoring crucial goals as she helped her team earn medals at the Olympics and World Cup.

## HEAD COACH

Jocelyn Prêcheur

Still early in his coaching career, Jocelyn Prêcheur has already amassed a wealth of high-level experience, leading Jiangsu Suning of the Chinese Women's Super League to a domestic quadruple in 2019, his first season as a head coach. Following a brief spell at the helm of Meizhou Hakka, the 42-year-old was appointed Paris Saint-Germain boss in September 2023, leading his squad to the Coupe de France, the Champions League semi-finals, and a second-place finish in the Arkema Première Ligue.



# 15 ONE TO WATCH

## SOFIA JAKOBSSON

Having played for Chelsea, Real Madrid and Bayern Munich, the Swedish forward has managed to be top scorer in both the English and Spanish capitals. Jakobsson made her Sweden debut in 2011 and has been a mainstay in the side ever since – representing her country at seven tournaments, including a Silver medal finish at the 2016 Olympics and Bronze at the 2019 World Cup. Since her return to London, Jakobsson scored two goals in three games in the Women's Championship, averaging just shy of a goal every 90 minutes.

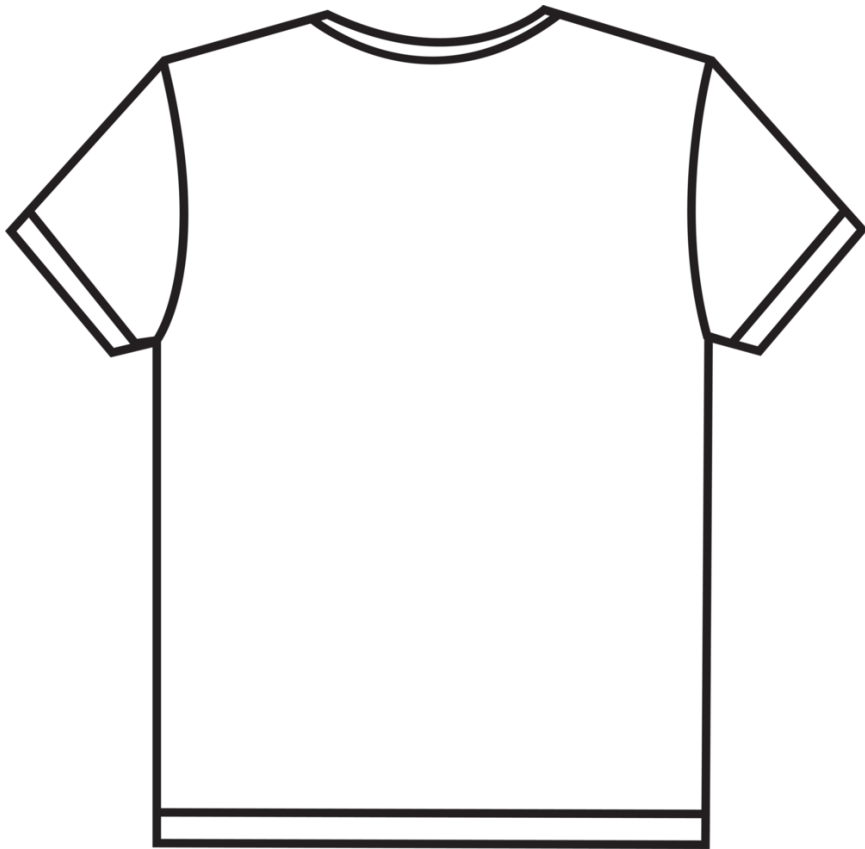
